DESSERT WINES

PORT

Port, the most famous of all dessert wines, comes from a most improbable viticultural area, the upper Douro Valley in Northern Portugal. Since the 17th century, steep slopes of slate and granite baked hard by the 100-degree sun have been terraced with thousands of walls, so that vines could be planted. Because of the difficulty of navigating the slate steps connecting the plots, every grape is still carried out on the backs of men. In many of the “quintas”, port is still made using the traditional methods begun centuries ago.

The very best of all ports is the Vintage Port. A vintage is declared only when there is a consensus of leading shippers stating that the wine is at unusually high quality. Vintage port takes longer to mature (15-50 years) than most classic wines, and it often reaches great depths of complexity. The good ones are big, fragrant, rich wines with a rather surprising delicacy in a wine so flavorful. It is an indisputable fact that a great vintage port is one of the world’s best wines.

The Ranch House has taken deliberate care in selecting and handling these excellent ports, and is offering them to be enjoyed by the glass.
